1. Qualifications required.—

- (1) A person shall not be qualified for appointment as **member of the State Commission** unless he-
 - (a) is of not less **than forty-five** years of age;
 - (b) possesses an experience of at least ten years as presiding officer of a district court or of any tribunal at equivalent level or combined service as such in the district Court and tribunal:
 - Provided that not more than fifty percent of such members shall be appointed; **or**
 - (c) possesses a bachelor's degree from a recognised university and is a person of ability, integrity and standing, and has special knowledge and professional experience of not less than ten years in consumer affairs, law, public affairs, administration, economics, commerce, industry, finance, management, engineering, technology, public health or medicine.
 - (d) at least one member or the President of the State Commission shall be a woman.
- (2) A person shall not be qualified for appointment as **member of the District Commission** unless he-
 - (a) is of not less than **thirty-five years** of age;
 - (b) possesses a bachelor's degree from a recognised University; and
 - (c) is a person of ability, integrity and standing, and having special knowledge and professional experience of not less than ten years in consumer affairs, law, public affairs, administration, economics, commerce, industry, finance, management, engineering, technology, public health or medicine.
 - (d) at least one member or the President of the District Commission shall be a woman.
- 2. Disqualification for appointment of President or member of State Commission and District Commission.— A person shall be disqualified for appointment as President of the State Commission or a member of a District Commission if he—
 - (a) has been convicted and sentenced to imprisonment for an offence which involves moral turpitude; or
 - (b) has been adjudged to be insolvent; or
 - (c) is of unsound mind and stands so declared by a competent court; or
 - (d) has been removed or dismissed from the service of the State Government or Central Government or a body corporate owned or controlled by such Government; or
 - (e) has, in the opinion of the State Government, such financial or other interest as is likely to prejudicially affect his functions as the President or a member
